DUES PAYMENT METHODS

Oswego Country Club memberships with golfing privileges may choose from the three (3) options listed below for the payment of the annual billing. Non-golfing classifications are eligible only for Option 1 – Payment in Full or Option 2 – Split Payment.

Option 1 – Payment in Full. Members who wish to use the “Payment in Full” option must pay the total billing for dues and fees (including restaurant minimum) for the ensuing year on or before February 1. For golfing members with memberships effective November 1 utilizing this option, the following incentives shall apply:

Total billing paid on or before December 1 - five (5) free guest green fees
Total billing paid on or before January 1 - three (3) free guest green fees

New members with golfing privileges accepted on or after November 1 shall be entitled to five (5) free green fees if full payment of dues and fees is received within ten (10) days of billing.

Option 2 – Split Payment. New members accepted prior to January 1 wishing to use the “Split Payment” option must pay one-half of the total billing for dues and fees (including restaurant minimum) for the ensuing year on or before February 1. For members accepted on or after January 1 but before March 1, this amount shall be due on or before the thirtieth day following the billing date. Payment of the total remaining billing balance of dues and fees for new members accepted prior to March 1 shall be due on or before April 1.

The “Split Payment” option is not available to new members accepted on or after March 1. Unless Option 3 is selected, total billing for these members shall be due on or before the thirtieth day following the billing date.

Option 3 – Monthly Payments. New golfing members will be allowed the option of having the dues and fees portion (including restaurant minimum) of their billing for the ensuing year, minus any required down-payment, spread over equal, automatically withdrawn monthly payments under the following conditions:

- Enrollment must take place at the time of acceptance.
- The dues and fees amount, minus any required down-payment, will be divided into equal payments based on the number of full months remaining in the fiscal year at the time of acceptance into membership (i.e. A new member is accepted at the April Board meeting. There would be 6 full months remaining in the fiscal year. Therefore, the dues and fees amount would be divided into six (6) equal payments.).
- The first installment, or down-payment as applicable, must be paid to Oswego Country Club by check or cash prior to the membership being activated. The remaining payments must be paid utilizing the automatic withdrawal method approved by Oswego Country Club.

- Initiation fees are due and payable by check or cash with the first installment or down-payment as applicable.
- Members must sign any and all required documents to allow for an automatic withdrawal system to be utilized for monthly payments. This system will be administered by a single banking institution selected and approved by the Board. Monthly payments through other methods will not be allowed.
- A monthly service fee will be charged in an amount to be determined and published annually by Oswego Country Club.
- The automatic withdrawal will be made on the first banking day of each month. If funds are not available to the banking institution for automatic withdrawal on that day, another attempt will be made five (5) banking days following the first attempt (*Late fees assessed by the banking institution are not regulated by OCC and shall be due and owing the bank*). Should funds still be insufficient or not available at the second attempt, the member shall stand suspended and assessed a fifty dollar (\$50) OCC penalty. Suspension shall terminate all privileges related to membership. Members who have their membership suspended shall not be allowed to utilize the facilities of the Club at any time during the term of the suspension, including as a guest or as a participant in a tournament or outing.

On a one time basis, a member whose funds are not available or insufficient for automatic withdrawal by the second attempt shall be allowed to self-pay the monthly amount plus penalty to OCC by cash or check. This payment will be considered due and owing by the last day of the month in question. Any member whose funds are unavailable or insufficient a second month (whether in succession or not) shall stand suspended and the full remaining balance of annual dues and fees shall become due and owing by the last day of that month. Failure to timely submit payment of the appropriate amounts due, including penalties, shall result in revocation of membership on the first (1st) day of the subsequent month.
