## On the Pro Side...

Hello April! I am glad to have the Golf Shop opening back up. The Golf Shop will open at 8:00 am daily for the month of April. The Golf Shop will be closing at 6:30 pm nightly. We will still have someone on site waiting for the remaining carts to come in. If you need someone please circle down around the cart barn for some help.

We have both key fobs and cards that operate the door for the locker room. If you are interested in owning one of these for \$10 please call the golf Shop or stop in to let us know. This is not an instant process unfortunately. We are working on getting ahead of this as quick as possible but as always appreciate your patience.

We are currently working without an Assistant Professional. We have 3 fine young men working in the shop along with handling the outside duties. We are training on the run. I have no doubt mistakes will be made. Please send me an email or see me individually if any situations arise. We will have more staff as the season moves on and school and sports wind down.

A few friendly reminders for members new and old. Tee times are made on the internet or by calling the Golf Shop. If your pin is not working or you do not know what it is you may get this information at the business office or through Hoagie. You are not to be on a cart without first making the Golf Shop aware. Our carts are rented by the rider. It is \$9 per person per 9 holes. Our 18 hole carts are \$18 per person. We expect no more than 2 carts per foursome. We understand occasionally someone might come late or hop on at the turn. Call the shop and report your cart use or stop in quick and tell us.

I am asking that we make more use of the Golf Shop phone as opposed to my cell phone. My staff can take messages if I am not available. I will not be answering calls for golf shop business while I am not working at the club or outside of golf shop hours. If it is an emergency my staff will have ways to reach me. If it is still a must for you to get in touch with me you may reach out to our executive board for help. I appreciate your help in maintaining my separation of work and life. Looking forward to a great year.

## The Course...

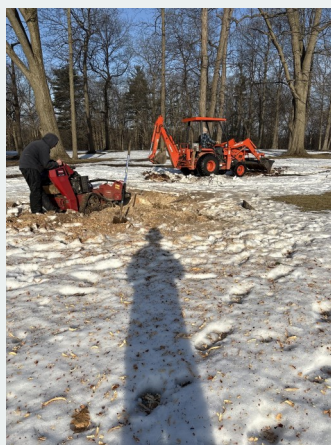
In like a lion and out like a lamb. I don't think a proverb could have been more accurate than that to describe how our March has transpired. Cold and snowy has given way to cold and not quite as snowy and we have already had some great days of golf this season. The maintenance crew has been busy with trying to get the mess that we made this winter cleaned up, and have been grinding stumps nearly daily from start to finish. Our course came out of winter very healthy and we have very little snow mold damage. The turf on our greens is lush, thick, and has beautiful color, and has already been mowed this spring. There is nothing better than the first good cut of the year and Neal did great job this winter prepping our equipment for another year of use. Good preventative maintenance makes all the difference for us and helps us transition into summer so much easier.

Even with preventative maintenance, we do have breakdowns, especially when doing hard work like tree and stump removal. We have been in and out of the shop replacing hydraulic components, cutting teeth and small items on our tractor and stump grinder as well as sending out parts for repair to keep us going. While equipment has been down, we have been cleaning out our shops and trying to improve our facilities to make the summer months more comfortable. With the quick snow melt we have been able to pinpoint some of the drainage issues that we have on the property and have made some drainage repairs.

This coming month is going to be another busy one, as the prep work of getting the course running can be very strenuous. Luckily we have already had many member volunteers who have come out to help clean up debris and have our annual member cleanup day scheduled for April 5<sup>th</sup>, with a contingency day of the 6<sup>th</sup>. Please be sure to use the link that has been in our newsletters to sign up. The member cleanup day is incredibly helpful to us and every person that we have here to help is appreciated.

## Facilities...

We finally made it to the opening of the Golf Season after a challenging winter. Some of us (not me) have already played a few rounds, and it's amazing how well the course has fared over the winter months. Soon the blossoms will be blooming and the Humminbirds will be back.

I hope everyone is excited for the beginning of the golf season and I can't wait to see everyone on April 5<sup>th</sup> for the volunteer cleanup day. It is of the utmost importance that we get an early start prepping the grounds for the season. And of course, it will be great to see the Snack Shed open on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

I want to give great thanks to Neal, Conner and Matt for digging up the sump pump drain line to the locker room that has caused flooding in the locker room basement. It was discovered that the perforated drain line was 98.2 % clogged with roots. The drain line has been replaced with a solid schedule 40 PCV drain line which will correct this problem.

### Minor Maintenance performed in March.

- Re-lamp the Club House Basement lights
- Replaced 4 burned out exit signs required by our insurance carrier and City Code Enforcement
- Fixed a section of the Pool fence that was blown out by heavy winds
- Had the grease trap pumped out
- Kitchen Fume hoods have been cleaned
- Club House carpet has been cleaned
- Fixed the kitchen ice machine

Now that the season is upon us, keep a lookout for any safety concerns and let me know so they can be addressed before someone gets injured.
